What is Gramatica Teacher?

Gramatica Teacher has two aims: to empower you to be a strong, knowledgeable, enthusiastic teacher of grammar and writing, and to empower your students to be strong, knowledgeable, enthusiastic writers.

He speaks English well, can read Old English (the language of *Beowulf*) and dabbles in Italian, Japanese, Spanish, Portuguese and German.

However, it takes it two steps further. Firstly, Gramatica presents students with a set of highly visual, colour-coded grammar tools, and trains them in their use. Secondly, when students are presented with a writing task in any subject area, Gramatica trains them to ask a simple question: "To complete this writing task, which of these grammar tools do I need?"

Lastly, Gramatica Teacher provides you, the teacher, with everything *you* need - the learning cards, lesson guides and assessment tools - to make students into knowledgeable, decisive, and empowered writers.
